This data has been collected as part of the ASER 2022 household survey in 616 rural districts of India. Data was collected between September and November 2022.

This table shows the age distribution for Std I in each state. For example in Andhra Pradesh, of all children enrolled in Std I, 16.8% children are 5 years old or younger, 59.6% are 6 years old, 18.1% are 7, and 5.6% are 8 or older.
