

ENROLLMENT: WHERE ARE YOUNG CHILDREN ENROLLED AT AGE 5 AND 6?

This data has been collected as part of the ASER 2022 household survey in 616 rural districts of India. Data was collected between September and November 2022.

For each state, this table shows the percentage of children age 5 and 6 who are enrolled in anganwadis, government or private pre-schools/pre-primary classes, or in school (government or private). Children who are not currently enrolled anywhere is also given.
